## **Sixth Appellate District Announces Destruction of Old Court Records**

San Jose—The Court of Appeal for the [Sixth Appellate District](#) (San Jose) has announced its intention to destroy the following criminal, juvenile, and civil records pursuant to Rule 10.1028(c), California Rules of Court:

- All criminal and juvenile cases (excluding those with published opinions) designated in records transfer lists 39 and 41 encompassing criminal and juvenile cases preserved for a period longer than 20 years.
- All civil cases (excluding those with published opinions) designated in records transfer list 84 encompassing civil cases preserved for a period longer than 10 years.
