Security Systems Program Policy

Members reviewed the draft policy in the materials, which had been edited and reformatted since they had previously seen it as an internal document. He indicated that, after Executive and Planning Committee approval, the committee will be asked to vote on posting a public Invitation to Comment on the policy for 30-days. Following the public comment period, the committee will consider any comments received prior to submitting a recommendation report to the Judicial Council that it adopt the proposed policy.
