

SAMPLE DATA 1—CURRENT PERIOD SECTION

Non-delinquent: One (1) citation filed, individual agreed to \$30/month installment agreement, six payments received by court.
 Delinquent: One (1) citation is filed and individual fails to appear in court or make a payment on the due date. A \$648 case, including \$300 civil assessment is established as delinquent. Individual fails to respond to the courts' two delinquency notices and three attempted telephone calls. Case is referred to a private vendor for collections. Individual is located via skip tracing, signs a 12-month, \$25.00 installment payment agreement. Individual made three installment payments during the reporting period and submits a request for an ability to pay determination. The court reduces \$648 initial fine amount to \$225. At year end, the plan is current and \$150 remains unpaid.

Delinquent: Private vendor’s reported ending balance for FY2019-20 is 34 cases with corresponding value of \$9,399.

FY2020-21 transactions:

Non-delinquent: Court collected a total of \$2,823 from 23 cases in inventory.

Delinquent: Private vendor collected \$1,948 from 15 delinquent cases in inventory.

Total of \$292.00 in operating costs recovered (15% commission)

Total adjustments of \$729 approved by the court (includes ability to pay determinations, community service, etc.)

Total court-ordered debt discharged from accountability \$2,739, nine (9) associated cases classified as “closed”.

At year end, \$895 in payments received from accounts with unpaid balance of \$3,194 carried over from prior year.
