- 1. This report is the first submission of all for quarters. As our County Auditor's office has limited personnel, our ROR can only be submitted on an annual basis.
- 2. Line I.B.5: Combined Collections section had to be used in lue of the specific source sections, as the monthly collections reports from our system used to gather the collection data does not distinguish which fines and fees were received with which specific payment modes. Such as, the amount for total collected civil assessments is not broken down by how it was paid on.
- 3. Line I.B.5.(2).: The fees charged by FTB and /or other thrid party collection agency are based on all fines and fees collected, not just what was specifically for Civil Assessments. Currently, there is no way to to distinguish the charge per fine/fee per case. The amounts used within this report are the total amounts charged by the collection agencies for total fines and fees collected by them.
