Informational Item – Assembly Bill 1450 and Companion Rule Proposal

Receive information about Assembly Bill 1450, which would amend Code of Civil Procedure section 271 to eliminate the requirement that an original reporter's transcript be in paper format and the companion proposal to amend rule 8.144 to establish formatting requirements for reporter's transcripts delivered in electronic form.

Item 3

Privacy Project: Preliminary Phase

For the joint project of the Appellate Advisory Committee and Information Technology Advisory Committee to provide guidance on privacy to the trial and appellate courts, a preliminary draft of a Privacy Resource Guide has been prepared. JATS should review the table of contents and the initial sections of the Privacy Resource Guide prepared by staff and provide input and direction on this project.
