Trial Courts: Allocations From the State Trial Court Improvement and Modernization Fund

> Judicial Council Meeting April 24, 2014

Role of the Judicial Council

- The Judicial Council has the statutory authority to allocate funding appropriated in the annual budget act from the State Trial Court Improvement and Modernization Fund (IMF).
- The Trial Court Budget Advisory Committee (TCBAC) has provided recommendations for allocations from the IMF.

TCBAC Rev/Exp Subcommittee

 The Revenue and Expenditure Subcommittee met on October 31 and November 1, 2013 to review the IMF revenues and propose 2014-2015 allocation levels from the IMF.

 In 2013-2014 the IMF experienced a deficit of \$26.3 million. The TCBAC is recommending an allocation level that is projected to result in a \$13.1 million deficit in 2014-2015.

Trial Court Budget Advisory Committee

- Trial Court Budget Advisory Committee took action on its recommendations to the council at its January 16, March 25, and April 17, 2014 meetings.
- All of the recommendations presented today were approved unanimously (30-0).



Recommendation 1

 Beginning with fiscal year (FY) 2014-2015, no longer transfer \$20 million revenue from the State Trial Court Improvement and Modernization Fund (IMF) to the Trial Court Trust Fund (TCTF).



Recommendation 2

- Allocate \$78.4 million from the IMF in FY 2014-2015
 - Maintaining 23 projects and programs at their 2013-2014 allocation levels
 - Transfer ongoing costs from and to the TCTF for 3 programs
 - Eliminate the \$34,000 in ongoing cost for the Employee Assistance Program for Bench Officers
 - Increase and decrease funding for 34 projects and programs from their FY 2013-2014 allocation levels, for a net overall decrease of \$1.9 million

Recommendation 3

 Direct the Judicial Council Technology Committee to develop a technology plan that would result in the future elimination of subsidies from the IMF and the TCTF to courts for CCMS V3 and Sustain Justice Edition costs.
