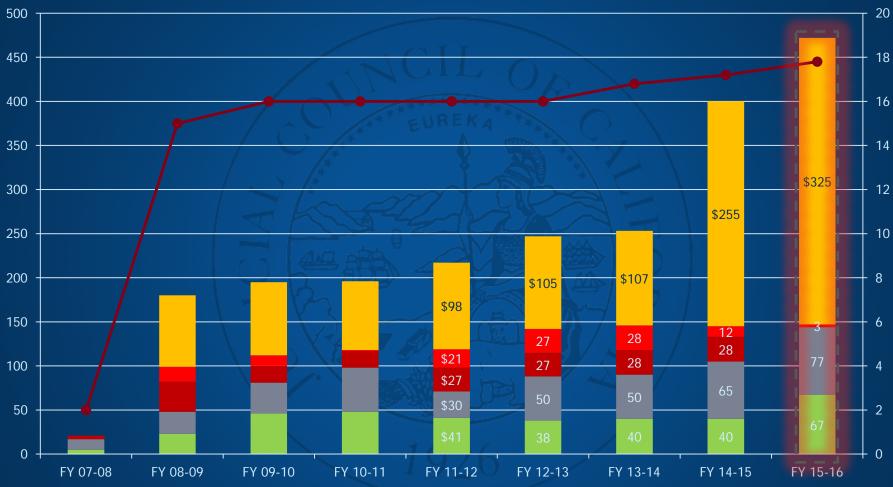

- Need to maintain buildings taken off SB1407 replacement list





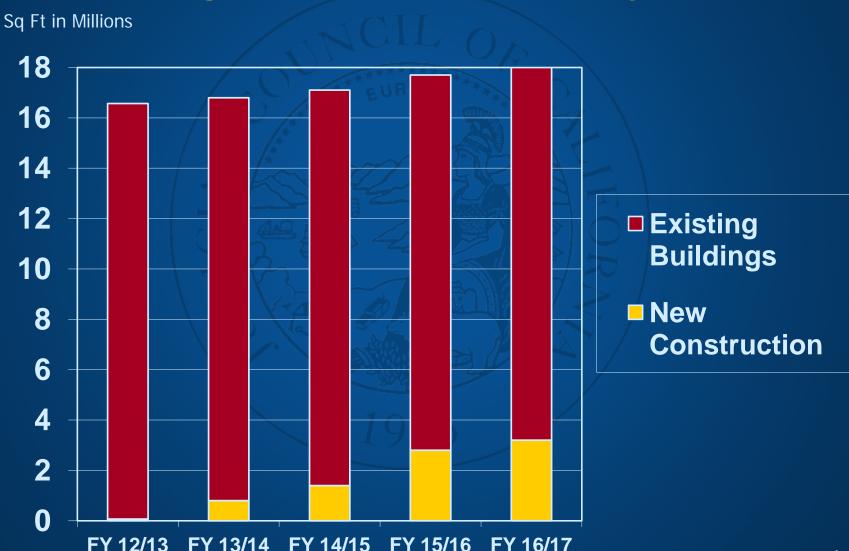
