



Notice of Action by E-mail Between Meetings for Judicial Council Technology Committee

In accordance with California Rules of Court, rule 10.75(o)(1)(B), public notice is hereby given that the Judicial Council Technology Committee (JCTC) proposes to act by email between meetings on January 30, 2015 at 11:00 a.m.. Modoc Superior Court has requested Judicial Council staff's assistance to modify their case management system configuration to calculate the distribution of fees and fines. Without this assistance, the court would have to manually calculate the base fine amount, which increases the risk of error and inaccurate distributions as well as being less efficient. Because council staff assistance on this request is estimated to exceed 50 hours, JCTC approval of the request is required. Due to the limited availability of JCTC members and the advisory body's other priorities, the JCTC does not have time to consider this request at a meeting in a timely manner. Accordingly, the Chair has concluded that prompt action by way of an action by email between meetings is necessary.
