Probation revoked

The court orders that the probation of HERMAN JASON COHEN, State Bar Number 188783, is revoked. The court further orders that HERMAN JASON COHEN is suspended from the practice of law for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

- 1. HERMAN JASON COHEN is suspended from the practice of law for a minimum of the first 60 days of his probation (with credit given for the period of involuntary inactive enrollment which commenced on February 1, 2018), and he will remain suspended until the following conditions are satisfied:
 - i. He submits to the Office of Probation satisfactory evidence of his completion of the State Bar's Ethics and Client Trust Accounting Schools and passage of the tests given at the end of those sessions; and
 - ii. GRAZIANI ON DISCIPLINE

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that DAVID GREGORY GRAZIANI, State Bar Number 276009, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

- 1. DAVID GREGORY GRAZIANI is suspended from the practice of law for the first year of probation;
- 2. DAVID GREGORY GRAZIANI must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on December 15, 2017; and
- 3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if DAVID GREGORY GRAZIANI has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied

and that suspension will be terminated.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).) DAVID GREGORY GRAZIANI must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2019, 2020, and 2021. If DAVID GREGORY GRAZIANI fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.
