- 4) If Juror Nancy Gronewold was biased against petitioner due to his race, did she fail to disclose her bias on her juror questionnaire or during voir dire at petitioner's trial? If she did, was the nondisclosure intentional and deliberate?

It is further ordered that the referee prepare and submit to this court a report of the proceedings conducted pursuant to this appointment, of the evidence adduced, and the findings of fact made. Petitioner's "Motion for Discovery," filed on March 13, 2015, is referred to the referee for disposition. All future requests for discovery in this matter must be addressed to the referee. If petitioner believes additional funds are required for investigator or expert services, he should apply in the first instance to the referee.
