JOHNSON ON DISCIPLINE

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that PAUL ARTHUR JOHNSON, State Bar Number 212950, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

PAUL ARTHUR JOHNSON must make restitution to the following payees:

- (1) Peter DeCuir in the amount of \$90,000 plus 10 percent interest per year from November 15, 2013; and
- (2) Lili Chen in the amount of \$130,900 plus 10 percent interest per year from November 25, 2013.
