Petition for review granted; transferred to Court of Appeal, Sixth Appellate District, with directions to issue an order to show cause

The petition for review is granted. The matter is transferred to the Court of Appeal, Sixth Appellate District. That court is ordered to vacate its summary denial dated November 10, 2020, and is further directed to issue an order to show cause, returnable before the Monterey County Superior Court. The Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is to be ordered to show cause, when the matter is placed on calendar, why petitioner is not entitled to the relief sought.

This court recognizes the urgency of the present matter and remains concerned about the risks that the conditions of confinement in Correctional Training Facility - Soledad may pose for petitioner and the other inmates confined there. We direct the superior court to expedite the proceedings to ensure prompt and effective resolution of these time-sensitive issues. To that end, the parties or the superior court on its own motion may shorten time for any filings to further an expedient resolution. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 4.551(h).)
