Petition for writ of review denied; recommended discipline imposed The petition for review is denied.

The court orders that DAVID ANTHONY HARPER, State Bar Number 112993, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

- 1. DAVID ANTHONY HARPER is suspended from the practice of law for the first 90 days of probation;
- 2. DAVID ANTHONY HARPER must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Review Department of the State Bar Court in its opinion filed on September 4, 2013; and
- 3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if DAVID ANTHONY HARPER has complied with all conditions of probation, the one-year period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
