Extension of time granted

Good cause appearing, and based upon Senior Deputy State Public Defender Jolie Lipsig's representation that the appellant's reply brief is anticipated to be filed by March 20, 2014, counsel's request for an extension of time in which to file that brief is granted to March 20, 2014. After that date, no further extension is contemplated.

An application to file an overlength brief must be served and filed no later than 60 days before the anticipated filing date. (See Cal. Rules of Court, rule 8.631(d)(1)(A)(ii) & (B)(ii).)

Counsel is ordered to inform his assisting attorney or entity, if any, and any assisting attorney or entity of any separate counsel of record, of this schedule, and to take all steps necessary to meet it.
