 - (30) Carlos and Olga Candelaria in the amount of \$3,500 plus 10 percent interest per year from March 13, 2010; and
- ii. She provides proof to the State Bar Court of her rehabilitation, fitness to practice and learning and ability in the general law. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, std. 1.2(c)(1).)
2. MARILYN SUE SCHEER must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Review Department of the State Bar Court in its opinion filed on March 18, 2014.
 3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if MARILYN SUE SCHEER has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

MARILYN SUE SCHEER must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination during the period of her suspension and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b)(2).)

MARILYN SUE SCHEER must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subparts (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
