The Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is ordered to show cause in the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, when the matter is placed on calendar, why the relief prayed for should not be granted on the ground that trial counsel provided ineffective assistance during the penalty phase, as alleged in Claim 5.

The return is to be filed on or before July 10, 2020.

All remaining claims in the petition are denied on the merits.

Claims 1, 2, and 3, except to the extent they allege ineffective assistance of counsel, are procedurally barred under *In re Waltreus* (1965) 62 Cal.2d 218, 225, to the extent they were raised and rejected on appeal.

Claims 2 and 3, except to the extent they allege ineffective assistance of counsel, are procedurally barred under *In re Dixon* (1953) 41 Cal.2d 756, 759, to the extent they could have been raised on appeal but were not.

Claims 6 and 7, except to the extent they allege ineffective assistance of counsel, are procedurally barred under *In re Seaton* (2004) 34 Cal.4th 193, 201, to the extent they could have been raised in the trial court but were not.
