The emergency petition for writ of mandate and request for immediate relief filed on June 3, 2020, has been read and considered.

The parties are notified this court may issue a peremptory writ in the first instance extending the time limits for the Citizens Redistricting Commission to release draft maps for public comment and certify final redistricting maps for the State's Assembly, Senate, Board of Equalization and congressional districts. (See Cal. Const., art. XXI, § 2, subd. (g); Gov. Code, § 8253, subd. (a)(7); *Palma v. U.S. Industrial Fasteners, Inc.* (1984) 36 Cal.3d 171; *Lewis v. Superior Court* (1999) 19 Cal.4th 1232.) Respondent and the Citizens Redistricting Commission must serve and file any oppositions on or before June 29, 2020.
