S223614 **TREJO ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that JOSE ANGEL TREJO, State Bar Number 262612, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for three years subject to the following conditions:

1. JOSE ANGEL TREJO is suspended from the practice of law for the first 60 days of probation (with credit given for the period of interim suspension which commenced on July 23, 2014);
2. JOSE ANGEL TREJO must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 19, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if JOSE ANGEL TREJO has complied with all conditions of probation, the one-year period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2016, 2017, and 2018. If JOSE ANGEL TREJO fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

S223620**TORJESSEN ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that JOHN CHRISTEN TORJESSEN, State Bar Number 141664, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

1. JOHN CHRISTEN TORJESSEN is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. JOHN CHRISTEN TORJESSEN must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on November 6, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if JOHN CHRISTEN TORJESSEN has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

JOHN CHRISTEN TORJESSEN must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2016, 2017, and 2018. If JOHN CHRISTEN TORJESSEN fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

S223636**CARVER ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that MICHAEL R. CARVER, State Bar Number 203925, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for two years subject to the following conditions:

1. MICHAEL R. CARVER is suspended from the practice of law for the first 90 days of probation;
2. MICHAEL R. CARVER must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Review Department of the State Bar Court in its Opinion filed on November 6, 2014; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if MICHAEL R. CARVER has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

MICHAEL R. CARVER must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
