1. ROBERT SHERMAN WYNNE is suspended from the practice of law for 60 days (with credit given for inactive enrollment, which was effective November 15, 2016 through January 16, 2017 (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6233));
2. ROBERT SHERMAN WYNNE must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Decision filed on February 15, 2018; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if ROBERT SHERMAN WYNNE has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

ROBERT SHERMAN WYNNE must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).) Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S247857**YOUNG ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that MATTHEW RICHARD YOUNG, State Bar Number 215562, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys. MATTHEW RICHARD YOUNG must also comply with the other requirements recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on February 9, 2018.

MATTHEW RICHARD YOUNG must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

S247990**MARQUEZ ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that RONALD TAN MARQUEZ, State Bar Number 272963, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. RONALD TAN MARQUEZ is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. RONALD TAN MARQUEZ must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on February 8, 2018; and

3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if RONALD TAN MARQUEZ has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

RONALD TAN MARQUEZ must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with his membership fees for each of the years 2019, 2020, and 2021. If RONALD TAN MARQUEZ fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

S247991**WAHL ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that MAUREEN REILLY WAHL, State Bar Number 260986, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that her name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

MAUREEN REILLY WAHL must make restitution to Matthew Carter in the amount of \$1,980 plus 10 percent interest per year from January 11, 2017. Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

MAUREEN REILLY WAHL must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
