Policies Regarding Cases Arising From Judgments of Death, policy 3, timeliness std. 1-1.1), and it will be presumed that any successive petition filed within that period is justified or excused (see *In re Clark* (1993) 5 Cal.4th 750, 774-782), in light of this court’s delay in appointing habeas corpus/executive clemency counsel on behalf of condemned inmate Regis Deon Thomas.
