To the extent they were raised and rejected on appeal and do not allege ineffective assistance of counsel, claims 4, 6, 7, and 12 are procedurally barred under *In re Waltreus* (1965) 62 Cal.2d 218, 225. (See also *Reno, supra*, 55 Cal.4th at pp. 443, 476-490.)

To the extent they were raised and rejected in petitioner's prior habeas corpus petition, claims 1 (subclaims (A), (B), (D), (F), (G), (I), (J), (L), (M), (O) (T)), 2, 5, 7, 9, 15, 21, and 22 are procedurally barred under *In re Miller* (1941) 17 Cal.2d 734, 735. (See also *Reno, supra*, 55 Cal.4th at pp. 443, 496 501.)

To the extent they could have been raised in petitioner's prior habeas corpus petition but were not, claims 1 (subclaims (A)-(L), (N)-(S)), 2-4, 6-8, 10-22, 26, and 39 are procedurally barred under *In re Clark* (1993) 5 Cal.4th 750, 767-769.
