OMID DAVID NATANZI must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

This order is effective forthwith. The petition for review is denied as moot, without prejudice to the filing of a renewed motion seeking the requested relief from the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code § 6102, subdivision (a) and State Bar Rules of Procedure, rules 5.162 and 5.342(D).
