Brown et al.* (Aug. 24, 2017, S238309) \_\_ Cal.5th \_\_, \_\_ [see order filed Dec. 20, 2016].) If Proposition 66 takes effect, the court would have authority to retain this petition and decide it under the newly enacted section 1509, subdivision (g) of the Penal Code. In these circumstances, the court has elected to rule on the petition at this time.

The Secretary of the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation is ordered to show cause in the Los Angeles County Superior Court, when the matter is placed on calendar, why petitioner’s death sentence should not be vacated and petitioner sentenced to life imprisonment without possibility of parole on the ground that he is intellectually disabled within the meaning of *Atkins v. Virginia* (2002) 536 U.S. 304, as alleged in Claim XVIII of the petition for writ of habeas corpus filed on July 3, 2006. (See *In re Hawthorne* (2005) 35 Cal.4th 40.)
