**S231416**      **SCHUSTER ON DISCIPLINE**

Probation revoked

The court orders that the probation of CLIFFORD NELSON SCHUSTER, State Bar Number 152164, is revoked. The court further orders that:

1. CLIFFORD NELSON SCHUSTER is suspended from the practice of law for one year.
2. CLIFFORD NELSON SCHUSTER is given credit towards the one-year suspension for the period of involuntary inactive enrollment which commenced on May 28, 2017.

CLIFFORD NELSON SCHUSTER must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243177****SANCHEZ ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that RUBEN DANIEL SANCHEZ, State Bar Number 164298, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

RUBEN DANIEL SANCHEZ must make restitution to the following payees:

- (1) Rodolfo Barranco in the amount of \$1,000 plus 10 percent interest per year from July 26, 2007;
- (2) Pilar P. Southard in the amount of \$10,000 plus 10 percent interest per year from February 1, 2003; and
- (3) Alejandra Bernal in the amount of \$13,000 plus 10 percent interest per year from July 1, 2008;

Any restitution owed to the Client Security Fund is enforceable as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.5, subdivisions (c) and (d).

RUBEN DANIEL SANCHEZ must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243181****ANDERSON ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that ERNEST LINFORD ANDERSON, State Bar Number 44784, is suspended from the practice of law in California for three years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for three years' subject to the following conditions:

1. ERNEST LINFORD ANDERSON is suspended from the practice of law for the first two years of probation, and he will remain suspended until he provides proof to the State Bar Court of his rehabilitation, fitness to practice and learning and ability in the general law. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, tit. IV, Stds. for Atty. Sanctions for Prof. Misconduct, std. 1.2(c)(1).)
2. ERNEST LINFORD ANDERSON must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on May 30, 2017; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if ERNEST LINFORD ANDERSON has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

ERNEST LINFORD ANDERSON must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination during the period of his suspension and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period.

Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

ERNEST LINFORD ANDERSON must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order. Failure to do so may result in disbarment

or suspension.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243183****BELL ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that BARBARA A. BELL, State Bar Number 264449, is suspended from the practice of law in California for two years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and she is placed on probation for two years' subject to the following conditions:

1. BARBARA A. BELL is suspended from the practice of law for the first year of probation (with credit given for the period of interim suspension which commenced on October 17, 2016).
2. BARBARA A. BELL must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on May 31, 2017.
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if BARBARA A. BELL has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

BARBARA A. BELL must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year after the effective date of this order and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment. One-third of the costs must be paid with her membership fees for each of the years 2018, 2019, and 2020. If BARBARA A. BELL fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining balance is due and payable immediately.

**S243248****LAMB ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that DAVID DALE LAMB, State Bar Number 199296, is summarily disbarred from the practice of law and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

DAVID DALE LAMB must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243253****CHAPMAN ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that CARL EDWARD CHAPMAN, State Bar Number 81665, is summarily disbarred from the practice of law and that his name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

CARL EDWARD CHAPMAN must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243272****HELTON ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that VICTORIA MARGARET HELTON, State Bar Number 141517, is suspended from the practice of law in California for one year, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and she is placed on probation for one year subject to the following conditions:

1. VICTORIA MARGARET HELTON is suspended from the practice of law for the first 30 days of probation;
2. VICTORIA MARGARET HELTON must comply with the other conditions of probation recommended by the Hearing Department of the State Bar Court in its Order Approving Stipulation filed on June 5, 2017; and
3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if VICTORIA MARGARET HELTON has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243274****KEEFE ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred

The court orders that KATHLEEN MARION KEEFE, State Bar Number 143817, is disbarred from the practice of law in California and that her name is stricken from the roll of attorneys.

KATHLEEN MARION KEEFE must also comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 calendar days, respectively, after the effective date of this order.

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

Recommended discipline imposed

The court orders that DRAGO CHARLES BARIC, State Bar Number 105383, is suspended from the practice of law in California for three years, execution of that period of suspension is stayed, and he is placed on probation for four years' subject to the following conditions:

1. DRAGO CHARLES BARIC is suspended from the practice of law for a minimum of the first two years of probation (with credit given for the period of inactive enrollment, which commenced on September 9, 2014, and continued until June 6, 2017), and he will remain suspended until he provides proof to the State Bar Court of his rehabilitation, fitness to practice and present learning and ability in the general law. 3. At the expiration of the period of probation, if DRAGO CHARLES BARIC has complied with all conditions of probation, the period of stayed suspension will be satisfied and that suspension will be terminated.

DRAGO CHARLES BARIC must also take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one year of the effective date of this order, or during the period of his suspension, whichever is longer and provide satisfactory proof of such passage to the State Bar's Office of Probation in Los Angeles within the same period. Failure to do so may result in suspension. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).)

Costs are awarded to the State Bar in accordance with Business and Professions Code section 6086.10 and are enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

**S243320****WOLF ON DISCIPLINE**

Recommended discipline imposed: disbarred
