San Francisco—The Court of Appeal, First Appellate District (San Francisco) has announced its intention to destroy 1,500 civil and criminal case records.

The records involve cases decided between January 1982 and March 1985 (case numbers A014500 through A014999) and cases decided between July 1985 and October 1988 (case numbers A032000 through A032999).

A complete listing of case numbers and titles is on file with the Assistant Clerk/Administrator. This announcement is made pursuant to Rule 10.1028(c) (1) and (2) of the California Rules of Court.
