Pre-Trial Monitoring Conditions

Standard Conditions: All PML's **SHALL** be subject to the following

- * Report to the Probation Officer of Tulare County at 1:00 p.m. the following business day, providing all Court paperwork, for a consultation regarding the terms and conditions of supervised release, and report thereafter as directed providing whatever information the Probation Officer requires.
- * Appear at all Court hearing and waive extradition if you fail to appear and are apprehended outside of the State of California.
- * Reside in the County of Tulare and not leave the State of California without approval from the Court or Probation Officer.
- * Obey all federal, state and local laws and all directives of the Court and Probation Officer.
- * Immediately report any change of address or telephone number to the Probation Officer.
- * Be subject to Court and appointment reminders via Short Message Service (SMS) text or voice messages. Be advised that message and data rates may apply.

Special Conditions: All PML's **MAY** be subject to the following

- * Submit to a search of his/her person, residence, automobile and any object under his/her control, at any time day or night, with or without a search warrant, with or without his/her consent, by any Peace Officer or Probation Officer.
- * Not own or possess any deadly weapon as defined by Section 16590 of the Penal Code.
- * Not use or possess alcohol, marijuana, narcotics or controlled substances without a valid prescription.
- * Enroll, participate and complete any treatment program as directed by the Court or Probation Officer based upon his/her identified needs.
- * Submit to chemical testing at the direction of the Court, Probation Officer, or any designated treatment provider.
- * Comply with all conditions associated with any electronic monitoring device (TAD GPS) as directed the Court or Probation Officer:
- * Have no further contact with the victim, in person, in writing, by telephone or by Internet.

Available Pre-Trial Monitoring Services

Based on identified needs, available community-based treatment services include:

- * substance abuse (referral based, community self-help AA/NA)
- * random chemical testing (Probation, AVerHealth)
- * anger management
- * batterers
- * mental health
- * parenting
