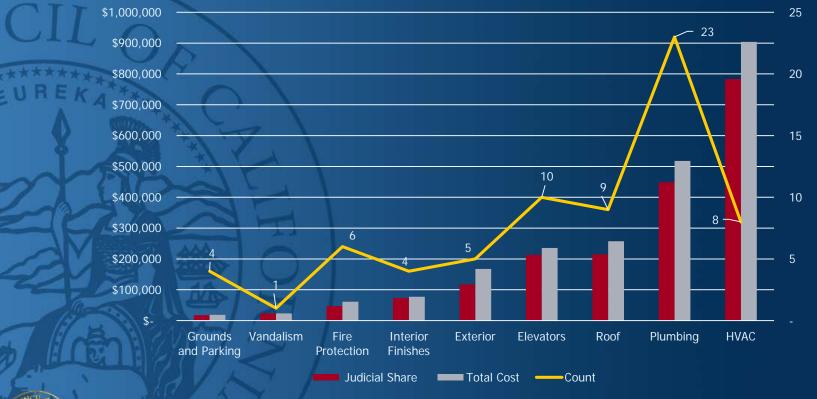

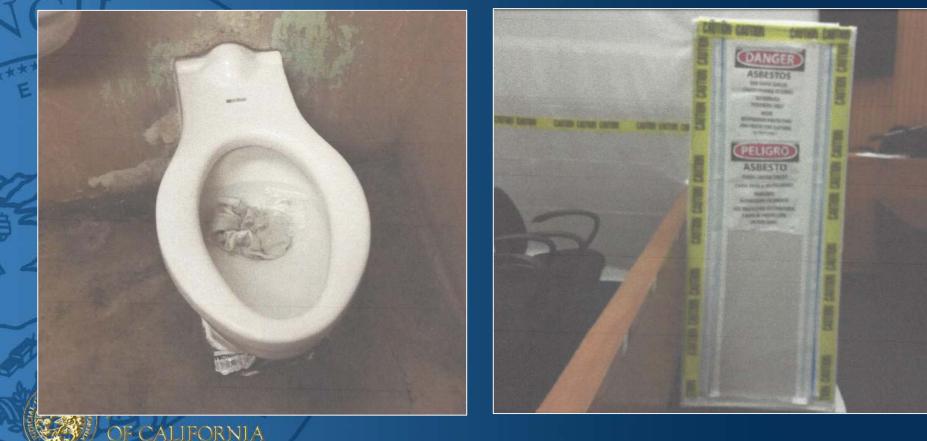

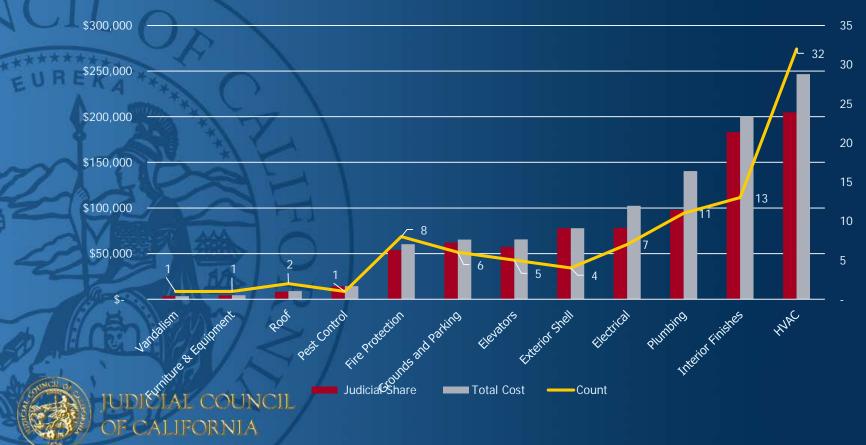

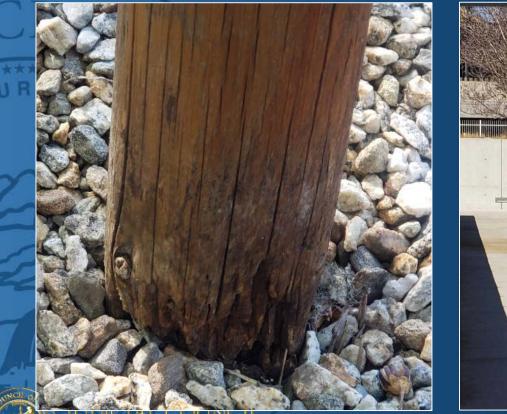

Reason for Increase: Cost increase is the result of hidden conditions consisting of managing demolition of the exterior when there was no interior drywall above the ceiling, repair of structural framing members discovered during removal of the exterior, and certain flashing details that could not have been designed until after removal of the siding and not reflected on construction documents.

Notes: FM Program Budget Share is 69.99%, therefore cost increase to FM Budget is \$66,491.

These scopes of work will require seven weeks of work on each of the three elevators to be completed after hours, which now adds twenty-one weeks of double time hours. Elevator union costs go from regular hours base rate, to double time after 5:00 PM.

Install hot and cold connections, control valves, steam trap and piping connections to existing systems. Install new 3 speed circulation return pump. Heat exchanger has been repaired multiple times and still leaks. If replacement is not completed, the heat exchanger may fail causing a P1 flood.
