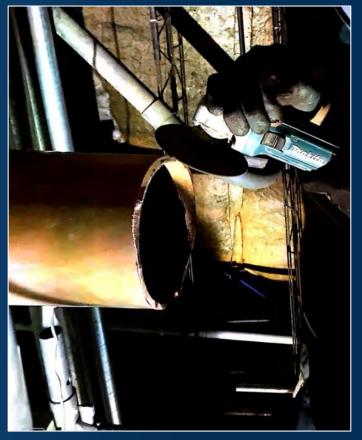

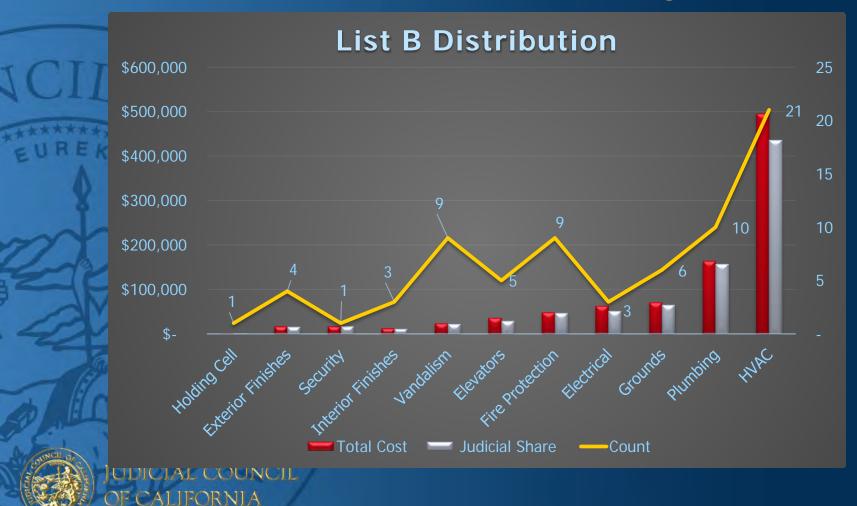

Action Item 3 Reallocation of Funds

- Reallocation of funds as follows:
 - \$577,500 from Statewide Planning budget
 category to Priority 1 FMs
- \$599,100 from DMF contingency budget category to Priority 1 FMs
 - \$500,000 from Unplanned FMs over \$100K budget category to FMs less than \$100K
 - \$2,750,000 from *Unplanned FMs over \$100K* budget category to *Priority 1 FMs*

Action Item 5 Reporting FMs Less Than \$2K / Firm Fixed Price – History & Information

- The Firm Fixed price contract included
 - Cost for management and support staff
 - Indirect labor
 - Direct cost
 - \$2K deduct data
- August 2012 to October 2013 Service Providers provided cost accounting of the work performed under Firm Fixed Price.
- On November 4, 2013 Judicial Council internal audit services recommended to discontinue data collection and TCFMAC approved.

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Action Item 5 Reporting FMs Less Than \$2K / Firm Fixed Price – History & Information

- \$2K Deduct (only for Firm Fixed Price):
 - Operation and Maintenance Contract set up with cost per square foot that the area to be maintained.
 - First \$2,000 is part of the service provider overhead.
 - For projects that have a cost of less than \$2,000, no cost is assigned to Facility Modification Budget as it is included as overhead in price per square foot. Costs are not reported or tracked.
 - For projects that have a cost of more than \$2,000, actual project cost is reduced by \$2,000 as this is included as overhead in price per square foot.

Discussion Item 3 **Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Grant Program: Answers to Questions Raised at Last Meeting**

- 1. Cost per kWh is extremely variable, due to large number of providers 27 profit/non-profit utility providers and 36 separate rate plans in sites where JCC is the customer of record for electricity (170 sites).
- 2. Costs range from 7 cents per kWh to 44 cents per kWh; depending on time of day, utility provider, demand, location, etc.
- 3. Regardless of cost, the pricing at the charging station will be set up to fully cover the cost of the electricity and possibly include administrative charges to help defray the cost of infrastructure installation.

Discussion Item 3 Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Grant Program: Answers to Questions Raised at Last Meeting

- 4. Different vendor agreements exist, but a common model has vendors charging a flat monthly rate per charger to the host organization; these costs would be part of the administrative charges built into the price.
- 5. Incentive rates for Electric Vehicle Charging exist, including some tied to EV Grant Programs, like the Southern California Edison program that would eliminate Demand-Based Pricing for the first 5 years of an installation which could prove helpful in recovering costs of installation;

- 6. Parking Lot Titleholders, if title is not held by the JCC, title holder would need to give approval for the installation; Current focus of EVI grants is only for JCC-owned parking lots to simplify the process.
- 7. Other Factors to consider: Risk Management (insurance for equipment, liability); usage language; joint occupancy agreement amendments, vendor agreements.
