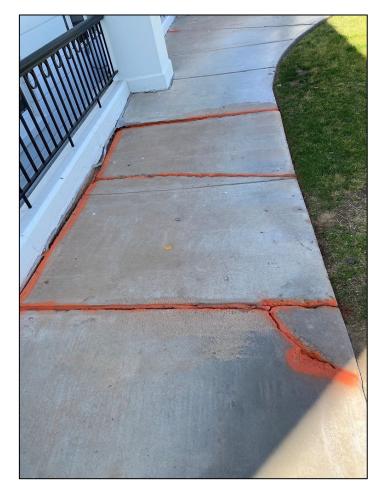

Reason for Increase: The original scope was for resurfacing only. The cost increase is required to replace one beam that was beyond repair.

Notes: FM Program Budget Share is 74.56%, therefore cost increase to FM Budget is \$95,816.

Reason for Increase: Original proposal was from service provider and did not include all the associated work. Cost increase is due to extensive abatement work and SFM requirements not included in the original estimate.

Addition of Fire Alarm devices at (21) locations in the building were identified by the State Fire Marshal and were not part of the original scope.

Notes: FM Program Budget Share is 66.13%, therefore cost increase to FM Budget is \$197,626.

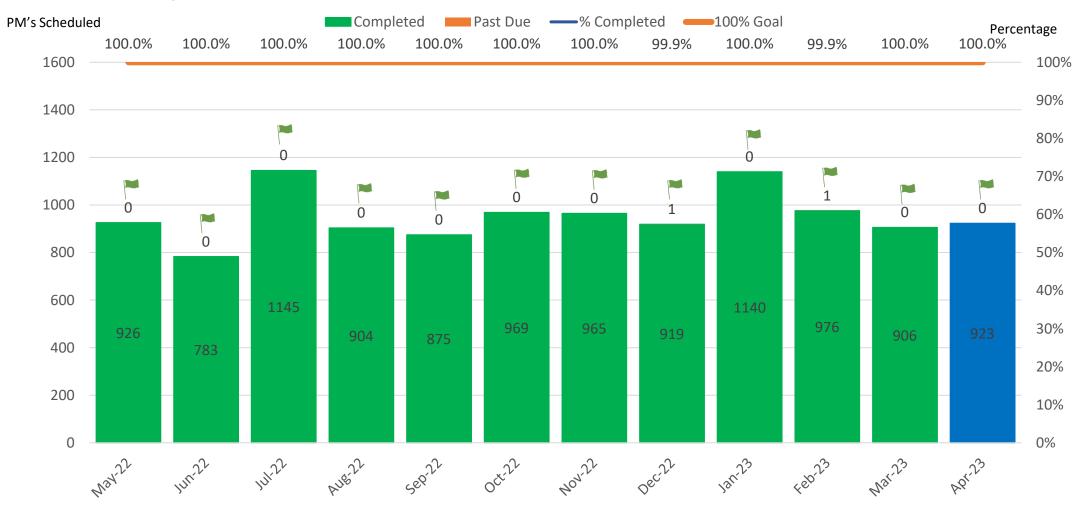

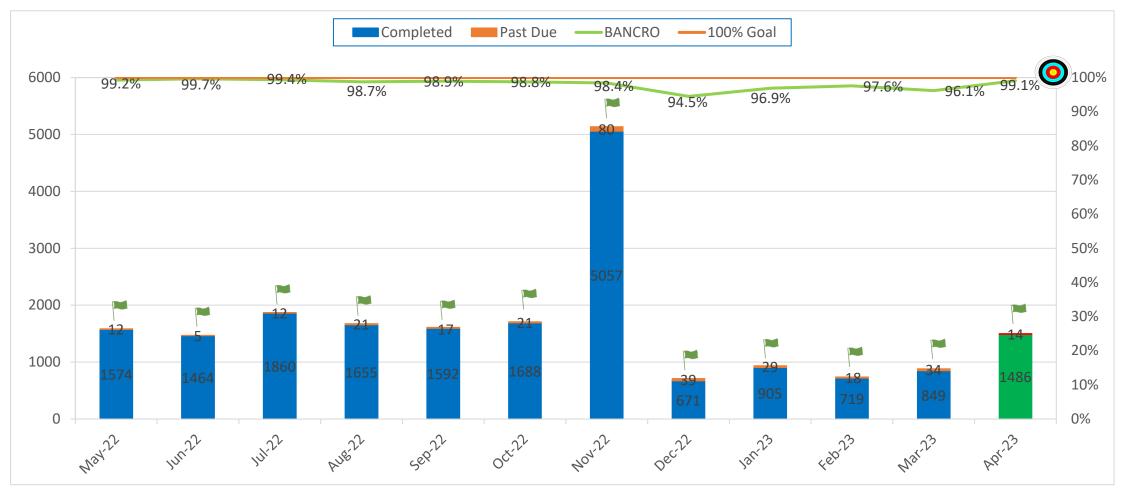

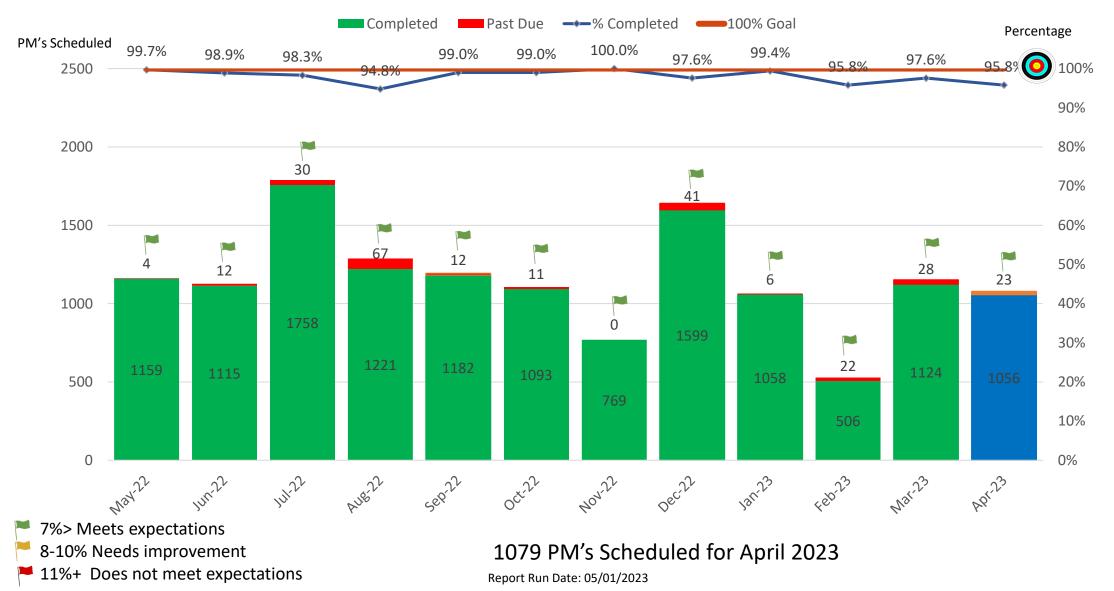
Enovity BANCRO – Past Due SWOs



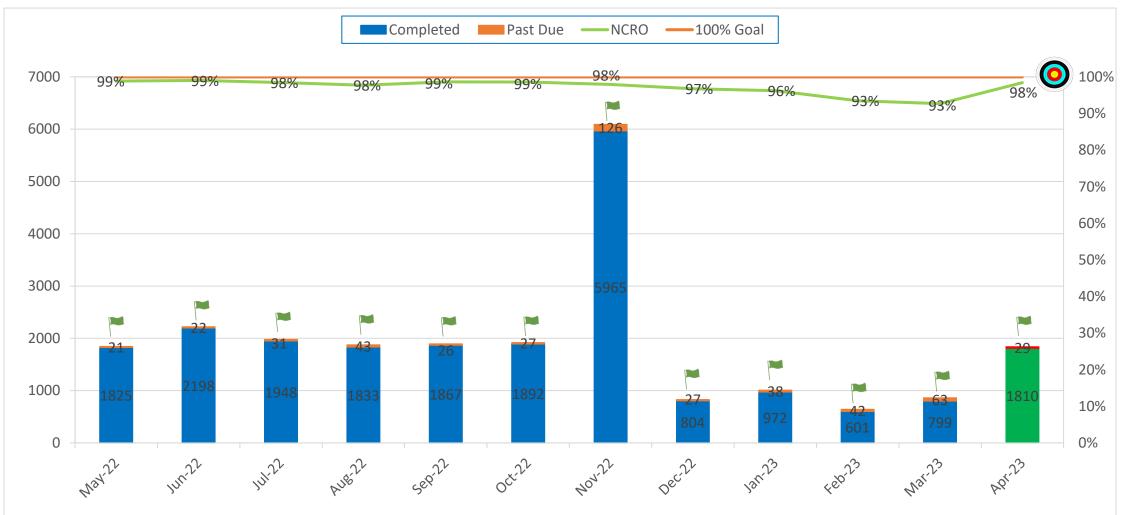

Pride SRO – FY 21/22 Open Liability in Technician Complete

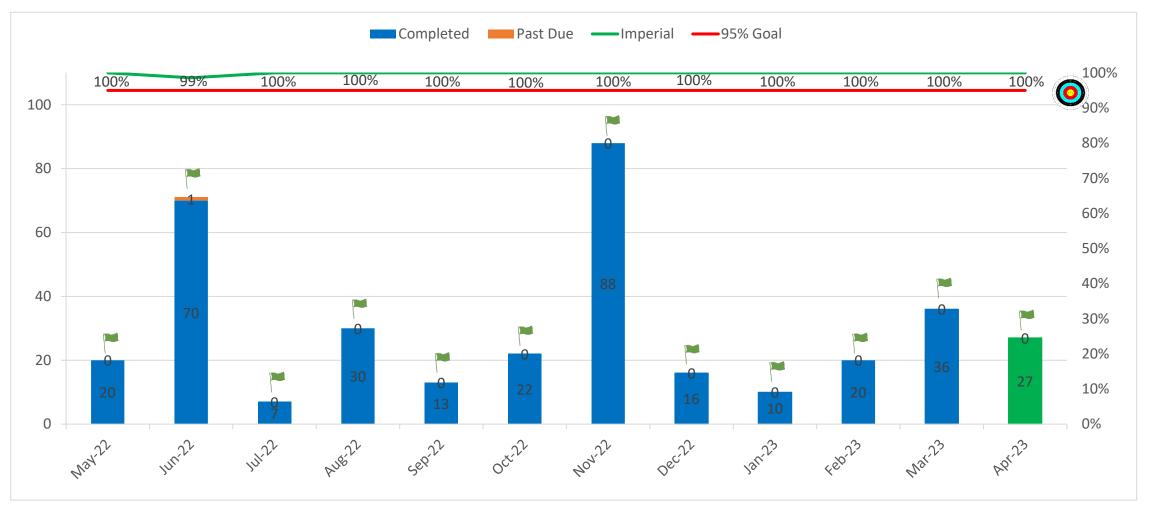

Imperial Court – Past Due SWOs

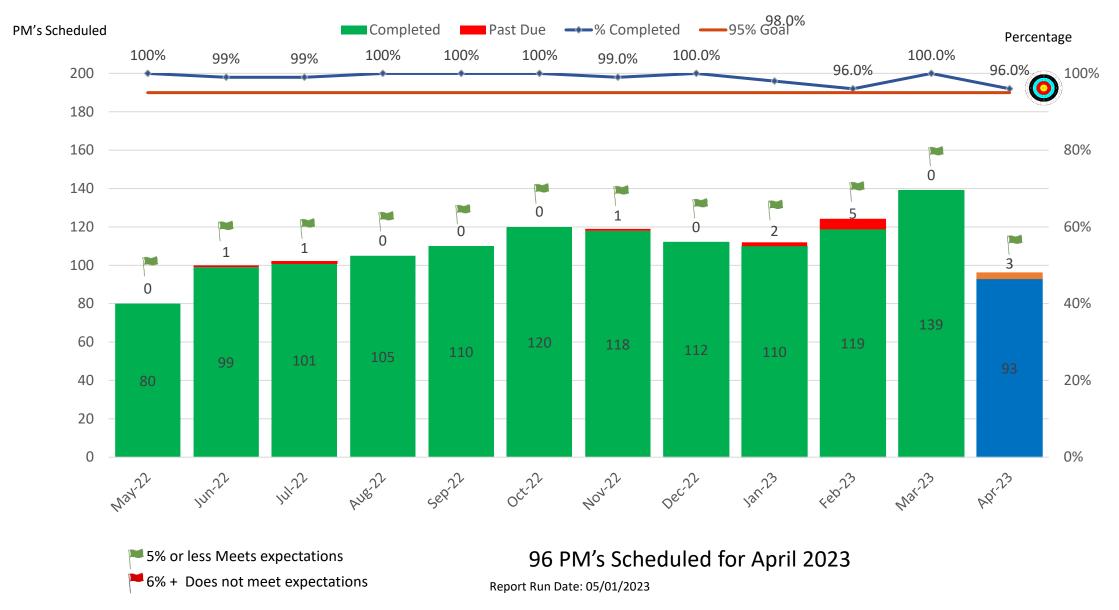

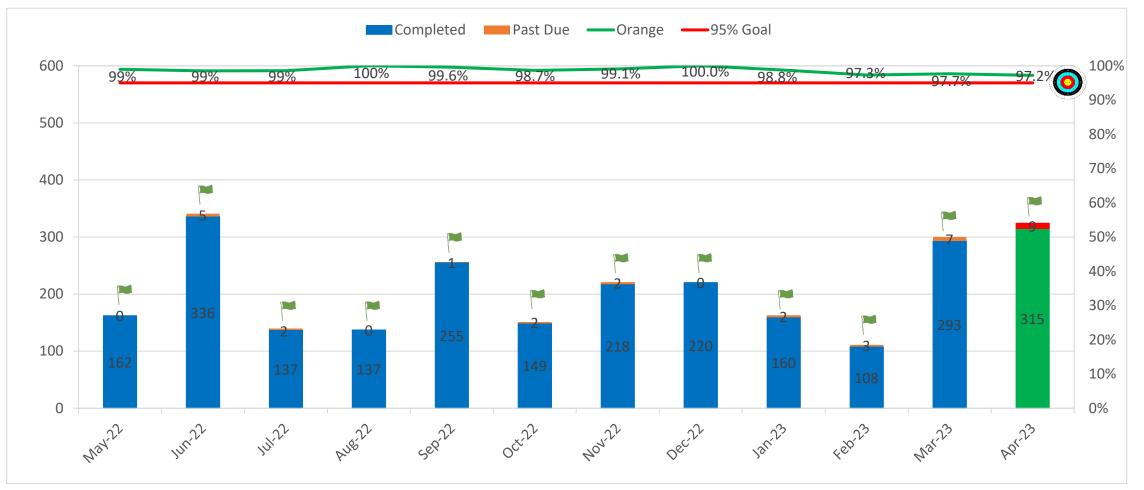

Orange Court - Preventive Maintenance



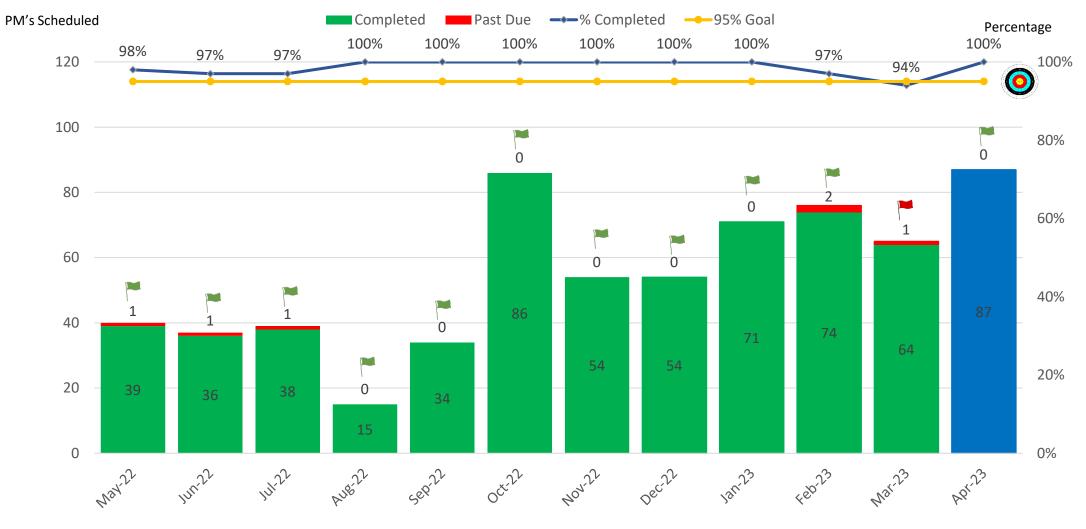
Orange Court – Past Due SWOs

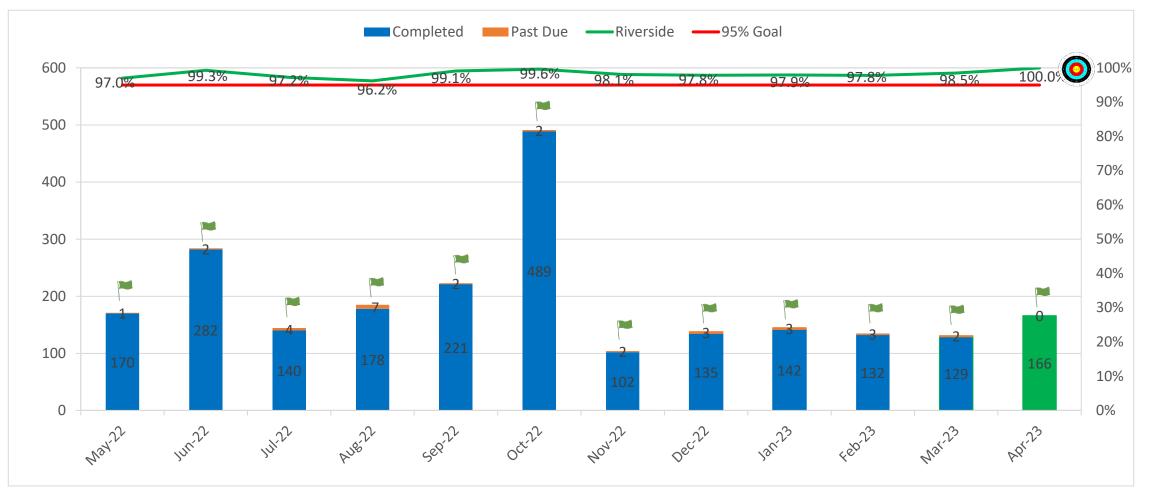

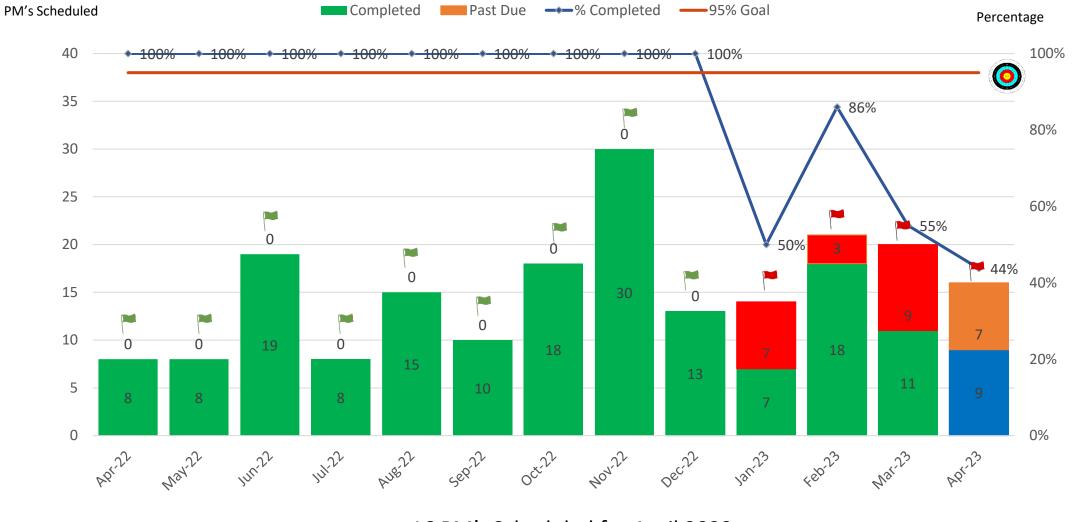
Riverside Court – Past Due SWOs

San Luis Obispo Court - Preventive Maintenance



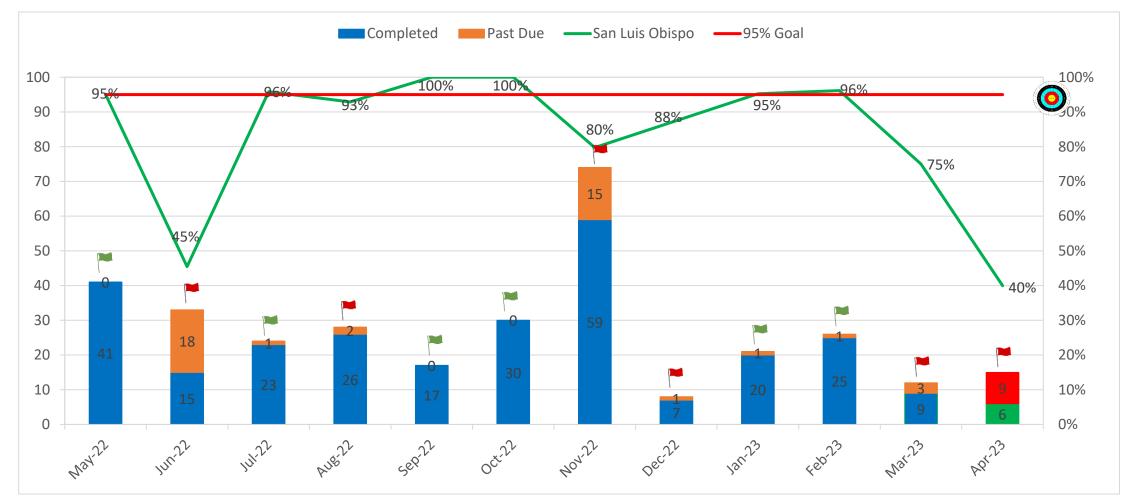

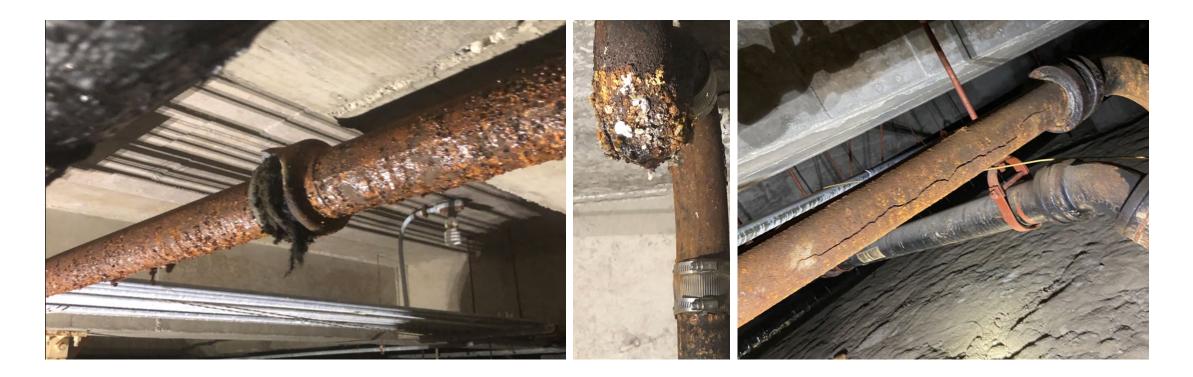

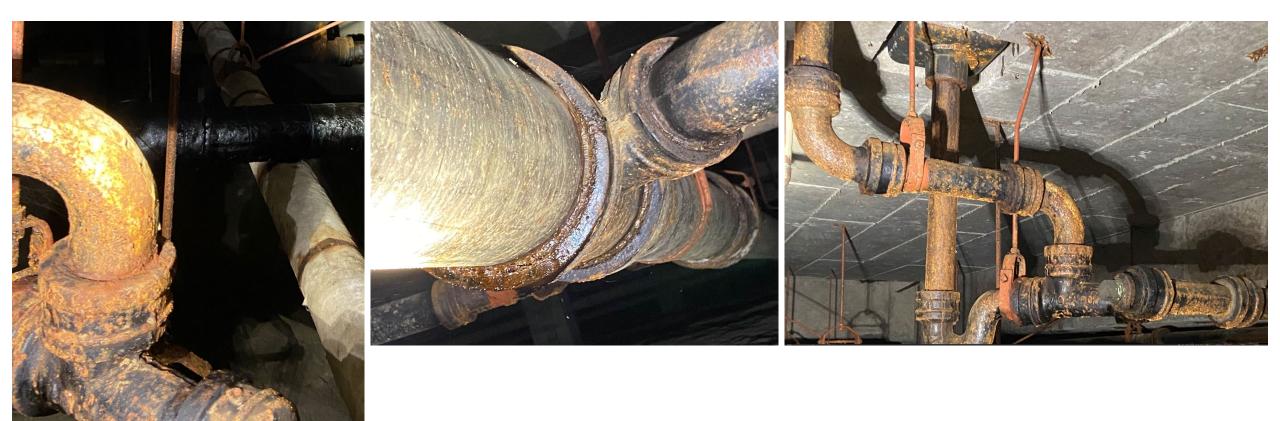
