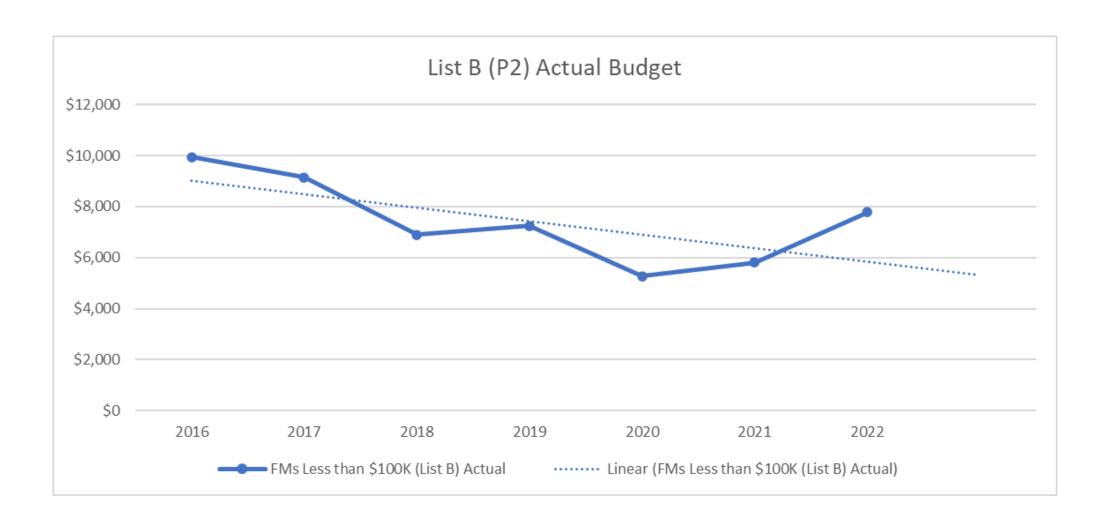

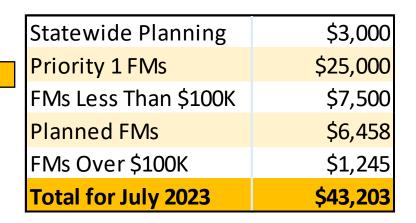
FM Budget Allocation FY 2018-2023

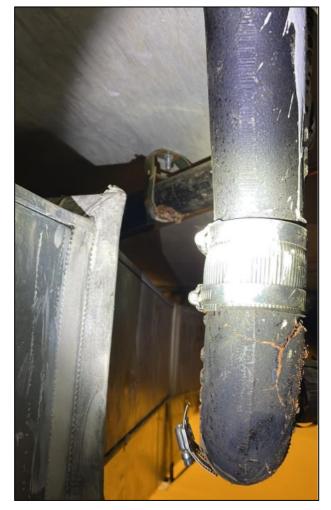

Orange Court - Preventive Maintenance



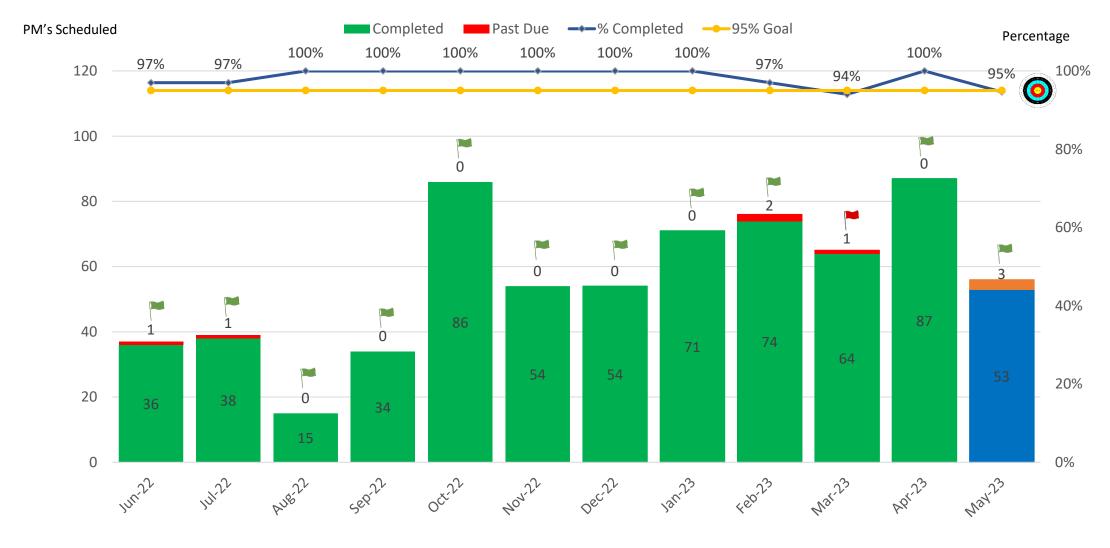

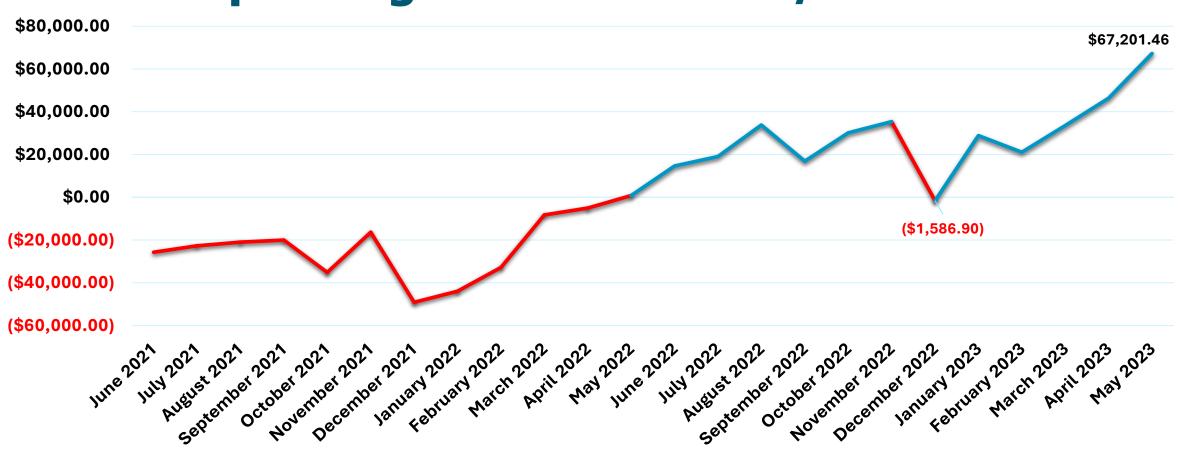
