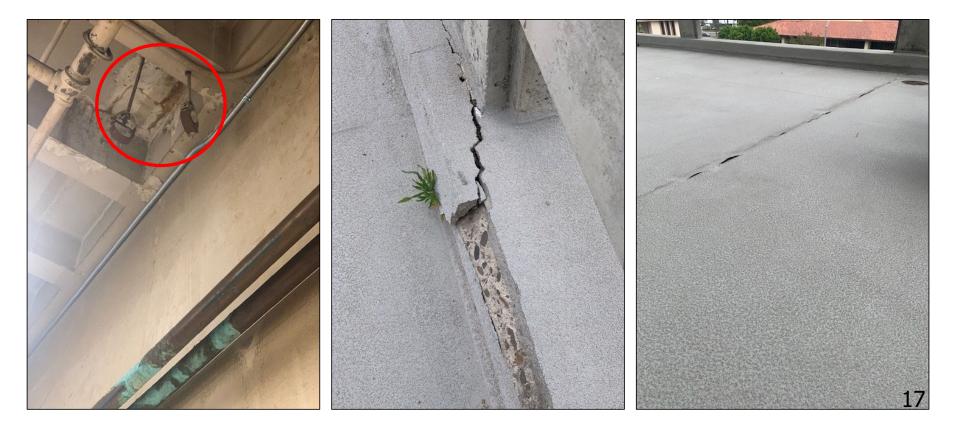

Additonal work include replacing (178) 1 x 1 ft ceiling tiles, 1,470 SF of carpet, (1) 6 inch cast iron 90 degree fitting, 6 LF of 6 inch piping, and (2) 6 inch couplings. Extract water from 2,330 SF of hard surface. Erect (1) 40 x 80 x 11 ft, (1) 13 x 3 x 8 ft, (1) 50 x 50 x 10 ft, and (1) 6 x 30 x 8 ft containment, and (1) 90 x 90 inch critical barrier.

It was determined during the project to have reached down to the 6th floor. The cost increase include additional work of extracting grey water, (1) 6 x 7 x 9 ft and (1) 7 x 14 x 14 ft containment, 71 axial fans, 38 dehumidifiers, 55 HEPA AFD, 33 water collectors, (5) extractor carpet cleaners, and (6) floor scrubber and pads.

Cleaned, dried, and sanitized additional 450 SF of hard surfaces. Repair/primer/paint an additional 20 SF of drywall.

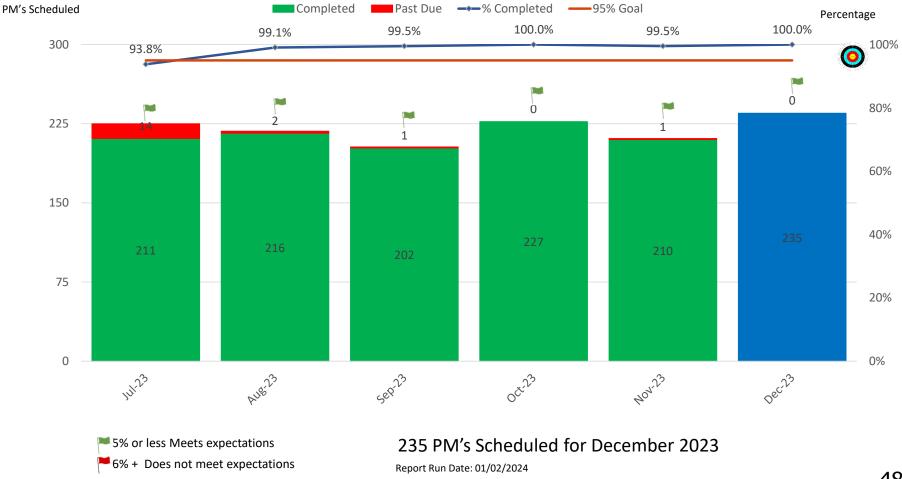

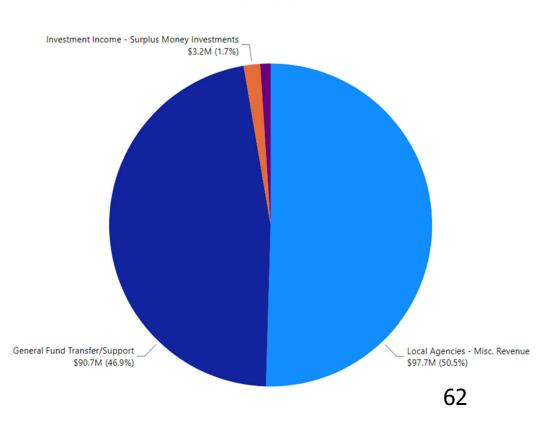

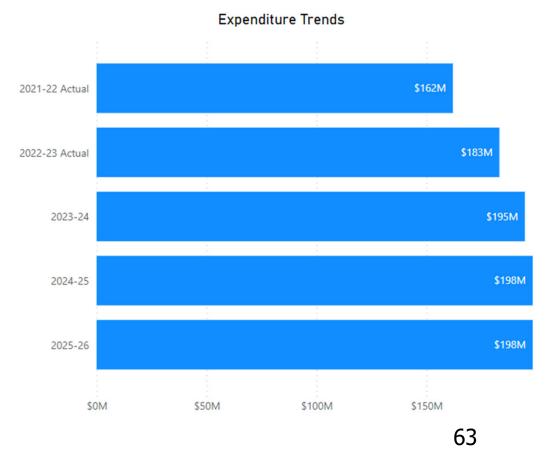


Revenues by Category (FY 2023-24)

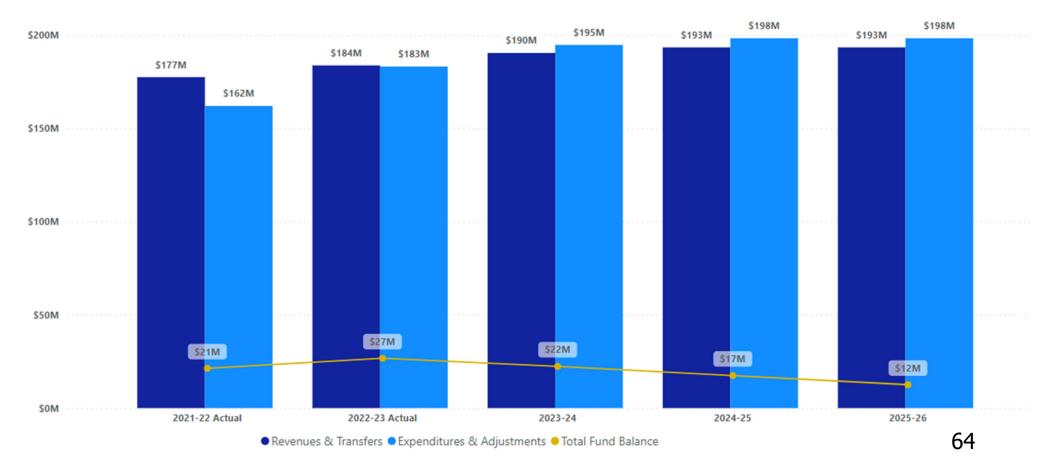

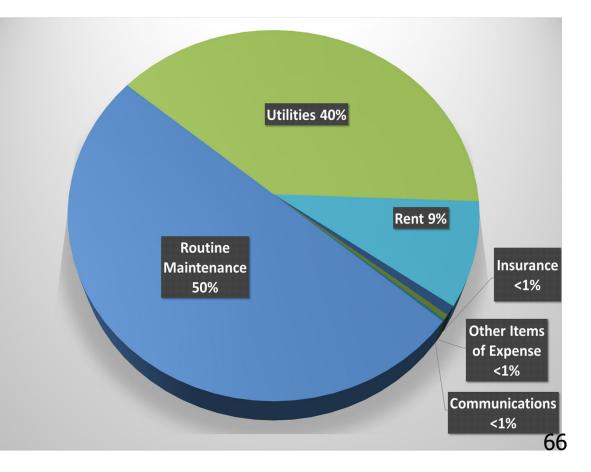
