Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions for Week of January 7, 2013 (Amended)

The California Supreme Court has announced that it accepted no cases during the week of January 7, 2013.

STATUS

#12-37 People v. Clancey, S200158. The court requested the parties to file supplemental letter briefs addressing the following questions: Does the Attorney General contest defendant's claim that he is entitled to a remand to enable the trial court to decide, under *People v. Tanner* (1979) 24 Cal.3d 514, 521-522, whether defendant should be returned to custody? (See Reply Brf. at p. 36.) If so, does *Tanner* remain good law? (See *People v. Statum* (2002) 28 Cal.4th 682, 695-696.) If Tanner remains good law, what showing is required to enable a defendant to avoid being returned to custody? (See *People v. Statum*, *supra*, 28 Cal.4th at pp. 696-697, fn. 5.)
