Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions During Week of June 3, 2019

The California Supreme Court has announced that no cases were accepted during the week of June 3, 2019.

STATUS

#18-48 ZB, N.A., and Zions Bancorporation v. Superior Court, S246711. The court vacated submission in this matter and directed the parties to file supplemental briefs addressing the following issue: If this court concludes Labor Code section 558's "amount sufficient to recover underpaid wages" is not a "civil penalty" recoverable under the Private Attorneys General Act (Lab. Code, § 2698 et seq.), should the trial court be ordered to deny ZB's motion to compel arbitration?

The Supreme Court of California is the state's highest court and its decisions are binding on all other California state courts. The court's primary role is to decide matters of statewide importance and to maintain uniformity in the law throughout California by reviewing matters from the six districts of the California Courts of Appeal and the fifty-eight county superior courts (the trial courts). Among its other duties, the court also decides all capital appeals and related matters and reviews both attorney and judicial disciplinary matters.
