Summary of Cases Accepted and Related Actions During Week of October 14, 2019

#19-163 *People v. Alexander*, S257190. (A151809. A152247; 36 Cal.App.5th 827; San Francisco County Superior Court; SCN220303.) Petition for review after the Court of Appeal remanded in part and otherwise affirmed judgments of conviction of criminal offenses. The court ordered briefing deferred pending decision in *People v. Stamps*, S255843 (#19-63), which presents the following issue: Is a certificate of probable cause required for a defendant to challenge a negotiated sentence based on a subsequent ameliorative, retroactive change in the law?
