

YOLO COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT ALTERNATIVES TO INCARCERATION PROGRAMS

HOME CUSTODY/ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE

Description of Programs:

On this program you are confined to your home and monitored by an electronic device for the length of your sentence. You may continue to work or attend school (continuing students in good standing) while on this program.

Fees:

There is an application fee due and payable at the time of the interview as well as fees to participate in the program.

How to apply:

You must obtain an application from the Work Programs Office within five (5) days of sentencing.

S.W.I.P./J.R.W.P.- SHERIFF'S WORKING INMATE PROGRAM

Description of Program:

This is a work release program that allows you to convert jail time to performing outdoor work for the County.

Fees:

There is a non-refundable application fee and an additional program fee to participate in this program.

How to apply:

Go to the Work Programs Office within seventy-two (72) hours of being sentenced. Bring the non-refundable \$25.00 application fee (cash or postal money order) and your court papers to the Work Programs Office to schedule your appointment.

Note: Both programs offer good time / work time credits

The Yolo County Sheriff's Department Work Programs Office is located at the *Leinberger Center Administration Office at 41797 Gibson Road in Woodland, Ca 95776. Office hours are Monday through Friday, from 8:00 AM to Noon and from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM.* (Closed on holidays and weekends)

APPLICANTS ARE ADVISED NOT TO BRING CHILDREN TO THE WORK PROGRAMS OFFICE.
